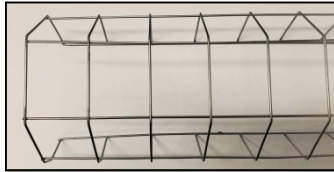

Wire Guard Installation Instructions

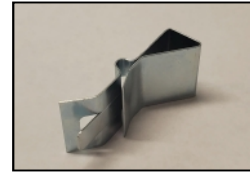

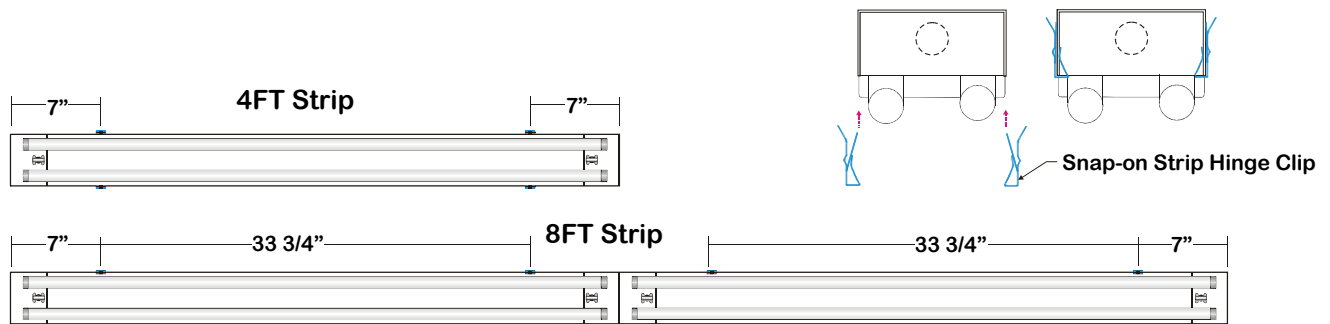
- Wire Guard, 1x



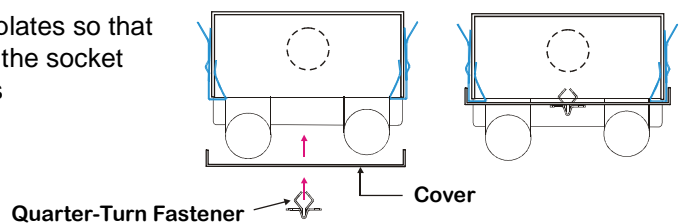
- Snap-On Strip Hinge Clip Package
Each package contains 4 clips



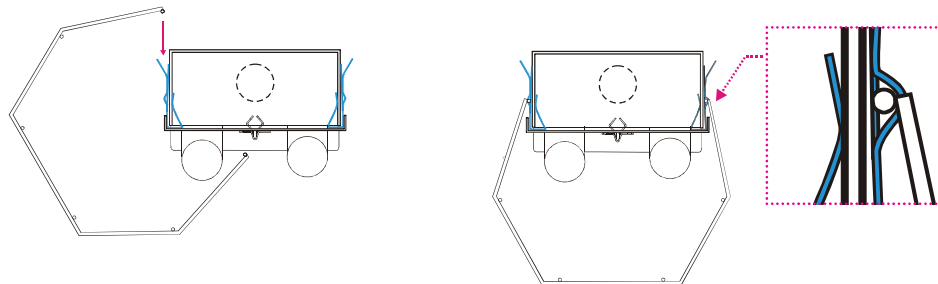
Step 1 Remove cover. Attach provided snap-on strip hinge clips to the side of the fixture housing: 4 per 4ft strip and 2 per side; 8 per 8ft strip and 4 per side, about 7 inches from each end.



Step 2 Place the cover over the clips and onto the socket plates so that the holes in the cover line up with the oval holes of the socket plates. Secure in place using quarter-turn fasteners (provided with fixture).



Step 3 Insert wire guard; slide and snap on each side of wire guards into place. Wire guard will sit in the groove of the clip.
